- Assist with preparation and management of classroom materials
- Encourage positive behavior, self-help skills, and good hygiene practices

- Observe children's behavior and report concerns to lead staff

Qualifications

Candidates must have **a minimum of 1–2 years of professional childcare experience** and a basic understanding of child development. Applicants should be dependable, team-oriented, and able to effectively support classroom operations.

A High School Diploma or GED is required, with **ECE coursework or a CDA preferred**.

Candidates must demonstrate strong communication and interpersonal skills and the ability to engage positively with children and staff.

Infant/Child CPR and First Aid certification is required (or willingness to obtain). All candidates must pass a **full background check and health screening** in accordance with state regulations.
