Seeking Nominations

The Nancy Klinger Memorial Scholarship Fund was established to honor the memory of Nancy Klinger, the first Coordinator of the Children's Program Administrator Credential (CPAC) project. This scholarship will support a current student in his/her effort to complete the CPAC.

CPAC faculty may nominate CPAC students who are enrolled in CPAC coursework at CUNY's School of Professional Studies and who are in good academic standing, have completed at least nine (9) credits toward the CPAC, and demonstrate a commitment to leading high quality programs for young children.

CPAC Faculty nominations will be submitted to the CPAC Scholarship Committee each semester. Each Fall and Spring semester, a scholarship to cover one CPAC course's tuition will be awarded. Scholarship recipients will be highlighted on the New York Early Childhood Professional Development Institute's website, with testimonials of how participation in the CUNY CPAC Program has impacted their role as a leader of high quality programs for children.
